Yves Cuilleron is one of the most renowned winemakers of the Northern Rhône. These wines are part of a refined winery allotment and a unique opportunity to own and taste slightly older vintages no longer available in market.

Tasting Notes

RP – “Slightly richer, with ample black raspberry, crème de cassis, bacon fat, minerality and violets, the 2011 Saint Joseph L’Amarybelle is similarly-styled on the palate, with a medium-bodied and elegant feel.”

Sweet spice, candied black fruits and some delicate notes of grilled tobacco make a nice complex and charming nose. Fleshy with velvety tannins and spicy finish.

Wonderful fresh primary notes in the first 5 years with the ability to age up to 10 years or more developing rich secondary characteristics.
